

NOTICE OF MEETING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Chapter 551, that the Board of Directors of **First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2** of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "District") will meet in regular session, open to the public, on **Tuesday, March 5, 2019**, at **12:00 p.m.** at 4330 Knightsbridge Boulevard, Sugar Land, Texas 77479, a designated meeting place inside the boundaries of the District, to consider and act upon the following:

1. Hear from the public.
2. Approve minutes of meeting held on February 5, 2019.
3. Approve Tax Collector's report, including but not limited to:
 - (a) authorize payments from the tax account; and
 - (b) review delinquent tax account list and consider terminating delinquent accounts.
4. Hear report from Champions Hydro-Lawn, including but not limited to:
 - (a) discuss authorizing mowing levee;
 - (b) discuss proposals to repair levee;
 - (c) discuss repair/landscaping projects in the District and take appropriate action;
 - (d) discuss hog fencing quotes and consider taking any action required; and
 - (e) receive update on rehabilitation and construction of a drainage swale at Stocksbridge Pond.
5. Hear Operator's report, including but not limited to:
 - (a) review and approve proposed repair and maintenance items.
6. Hear Engineer's report, including but not limited to:
 - (a) consider approval of report, pay estimates, and change orders for projects;
 - (b) consider approving award of contracts and/or authorizing engineer to advertise for bids; and
 - (c) discuss pump station construction and schedule.
7. Approve Bookkeeper's report, including but not limited to:
 - (a) authorize payment of District bills.
8. Hear Attorney's report and consider taking any action required, including:
 - (a) discuss Fort Bend County Office of Emergency Management and Fort Bend County Drainage District Functional Exercise in the Emergency Operations Center.


